We will now discuss the process for setting the Cimel clock you only do this if you actually want to change the time simply see the current time select view and then BAT so you need a watch that which is set to UTC or GMT Time from the main menu select password green increment to 1 hit green again then select DAT for date DAT you can change here the year the month the day and then the house GMT time and the minute. There is no seconds on there so you can only set it for the next upcoming minute and then wait until exactly that time on the clock and hit the OK button like so and thereafter ifi you want to ensure that the time matches up properly you can have somebody look at it on the screen or at any time go back and do a view BAT to see the time it is actually in the system.
